

Swap Meet Food Truck/Trailer

Mobile Food Facility (MFF Cat D)

A vehicle that will be used to sell non-prepackaged food that is cooked on the vehicle or any non-prepackaged food that requires preparation beyond heating, popping, shaving of ice, blending, portioning, assembling, dispensing or baking to a non-potentially hazardous food (PHF) form

General Operating Requirements:

- ✓ **Obtain MFF Cat D Permit:** see MFF permit packet for more detailed requirements
- ✓ **Business name identified on vehicle:** name, address of commissary
- ✓ **Food Safety Certificate and/or Food Handler Card required**
- ✓ **All food/beverages come from an approved source**
- ✓ **Restroom (toilet and stocked handwashing station):** within 200ft of booth
- ✓ **Garbage/trash storage and disposal:** in a sanitary manner
- ✓ **Proper waste water disposal:** Waste water shall **not** be disposed of onto the ground or a storm drain, must be disposed of into a sanitary sewer

MFFs at Swap Meet/Flea Market:

- ✓ Can include a staffed counter that serves non-potentially hazardous, prepackaged foods or hot/cold beverages and ice that is not potentially hazardous food (for example: horchata or other beverages) and that are dispensed from approved bulk dispensing units
 - Maximum counter space approved is 15 square feet
 - All the food items must be kept in a food compartment under overhead protection and must be stored at least 6" inches off of ground level
 - Beverages in bulk containers are approved with utensils for occasional stirring as long as the food is kept covered after stirring
 - The beverages must be dispensed from the containers through approved nozzles
 - Mixing of bulk beverages shall be conducted diligently to protect the food from contamination at all times
- ✓ In addition to this, the MFF can have 2 ice chests for bottled/canned beverages and 2 ice chests for prepackaged fruit cups with potentially hazardous fruits
- ✓ Additional permits (swap meet or other applicable permit) shall be required if the MFF engages in any operation other than explained above (including setting up additional tables for prepackaged foods)
