Environmental Compliance Technician Lvl I/II positions work predominately in the Hazardous Materials (HM) Environmental Health (EH), and Water Protection (WP) Divisions of the Sacramento County Environmental Management Department. **Environmental Compliance Tech Lvl I** is the entry level for the series. Assignments are performed in a training capacity. Working under close supervision, incumbents learn to apply knowledge and skills to perform fundamental office and field support work.

The **Environmental Compliance Tech. Lvl II** is the journey level in the series where assignments are performed under minimal supervision. Incumbents are assigned to perform the full scope of technical office and field activities to ensure compliance with environmental laws and regulations, and other technical duties. Incumbents assist with field investigations by collecting and preparing test samples, recording data, reviewing hazardous material plans, and preparing summaries and charts. Environmental Compliance Technicians support the professional work conducted by Environmental Specialists.

PLEASE NOTE: Eligible lists are periodically updated; applicants are encouraged to apply early to be eligible for all possible positions.

Minimum Qualifications:

Level I

- Either:**
- One year of experience performing technical support and public contact work in a regulatory, public health, or environmental service environment.
- Or:**
- Completion of 12 semester units from an accredited college or university in physical science, life science, engineering or a closely related field.

Level II

- Either:**
- Six months of technical support experience in environmental regulation or research support, performing the duties and responsibilities equivalent to those of the Environmental Compliance Technician (Level I) class within Sacramento County service.
- Or:**
- One year of experience performing technical support and public contact work in a regulatory, public health, or environmental service environment.
- And-**
- Completion of 12 semester units from an accredited college or university in physical science, life science, engineering or a closely related field.

Note: Up to one year of the required education may be substituted by full-time, or equiv. Part-time, experience similar to that described on the basis of 173.6 hours + 21.7 days = 1 work month = 3 semester or 4.5 quarter units.
