### Minimum Qualifications:

#### Level I

BS/BA in health science, public health, natural science, physical science, environmental science, or a related field, or written proof of acceptance of education requirements by the State of California, Department of Health Services.

#### Level II

BS/BA as described in Level I and 1 year of experience in environmental regulation, analysis, or environmental research performing duties and responsibilities equivalent to the ES I class in Sacramento County service.

OR

Possession of valid certification as Registered Environmental Health Specialist (REHS) by State of California.

OR

Possession of a Master's Degree from an accredited college or university in health science, public health, natural science, physical science, environmental science, or a related field.

**Applicants interested in Environmental Health positions are required to provide documentation of Registered Environmental Health Specialist**

**Environmental Specialist I/II** positions work predominately in the Hazardous Materials (HM), Environmental Health (EH), and Water Protection (WP) Divisions of the Sacramento County Environmental Management Department. Positions working in the EH Division require an REHS or written proof of acceptance of education requirements by the State of California Department of Health Services. **Environmental Specialist I** is the entry level where assignments are performed under close supervision.

The **Environmental Specialist II** is the journey level where assignments are performed under minimum supervision. Incumbents are assigned to field evaluations of facilities to ensure compliance with environmental laws and regulations and other professional duties. Incumbents may work in one or more programs including, but not limited to: EH programs of food protection; housing and institutions; recreational water facilities; WP programs of recycled water; storm water; drinking water supplies; liquid waste disposal; well construction; site assessment and mitigation; HM programs of CUPA regulatory compliance of facilities with hazardous materials; hazardous waste and underground storage tanks; incident response; and solid and medical waste disposal. All programs include emergency preparedness and disaster response. **PLEASE NOTE: Eligible lists are periodically updated; applicants are encouraged to apply early to be eligible for all possible positions.**
