**Environmental Specialist III** positions work predominately in the Hazardous Materials (HM), Environmental Health (EH), and Water Protection (WP) Divisions of the Sacramento County Environmental Management Department. Positions in the Environmental Health Division require an REHS or written proof of acceptance of education requirements by the State of California Department of Health Services.

The **Environmental Specialist III**, under direction, performs a full range of varied and complex work ensuring compliance with environmental laws and regulations. Duties may include, but are not limited to the following: conducting field inspections of regulated facilities; performing complex evaluations of facility permit applications; reviewing remedial action plans; ensuring compliance with permit conditions; developing, preparing, and presenting studies and reports to governmental boards and other groups; responsibility for leading other Environmental Specialists at the journey and entry level, and developing & implementing new program areas. The **Environmental Specialist III** is expected to exercise considerable independent judgment in the completion of assigned duties.

### CONTINUOUS FILING

#### Minimum Qualifications:

**EITHER:**

1. BS/BA in health science, public health, natural science, physical science, environmental science, or a related field;

AND

Two years of professional experience in environmental regulation, analysis, or environmental research performing journey level duties and responsibilities equivalent to the Environmental Specialist (Level II) class in Sacramento County Service.

OR

2. Possession of a Master's Degree from an accredited college or university in health science, public health, natural science, physical science, environmental science, or a related field.

AND

One year of professional experience in environmental inspections, enforcement, regulation, analysis, and/or research performing journey level duties and responsibilities equivalent to the Environmental Specialist (Level II) class in Sacramento County service.

*Note: Applicants interested in Environmental Health positions are required to provide documentation of Registered Environmental Health Specialist (REHS) certification.*
