Introduction

Please be advised that the Sacramento County Solid Waste Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) received and approved a Joint Technical Document (JTD) Amendment to the Solid Waste Facility Permit for the Kiefer Landfill. The LEA is certified by the California Integrated Waste Management Board to enforce state laws and regulations at solid waste sites within the County and City of Sacramento, including all active and closed landfills.

Description of project and LEA's determination

Kiefer Landfill is a 1084-acre existing landfill located at 12701 Kiefer Blvd, north of highway 16, South of Douglas Blvd directly off of Grant Line road, Sloughouse, CA 95683. On January 2, 2008 the LEA received an APPLICATION FOR SOLID WASTE FACILITY PERMIT from the Department of Waste

Management and Recycling. The type of application was an amendment, requesting that the revised documents listed below be incorporated into the current JTD:

- Revised text that reflects a transitions from “proposed” to “operational” for the antifreeze, battery, oil, and latex paint (ABOP) drop-off facility.
- A revised Solid Waste Acceptance Policy dated December 11, 2007 that includes the materials accepted at the ABOP facility.
- Text on the planned use of a non-reusable, degradable geosynthetic alternative daily cover (ADC) material.

The LEA finds that the proposed change is consistent with all applicable certified and/or adopted California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) documents; is consistent with California Integrated Waste Management Board State Minimum Standards; and does not conflict with the terms and conditions in the current Solid Waste Facilities Permit or with the current Joint Technical Document. The LEA approved the amendment on January 25, 2008.
