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## **Introduction**

Please be advised that the County of Sacramento Solid Waste Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) received and approved a Report of Composting Site Information Amendment to the Solid Waste Facility Permit (SWFP) for Lopez Agricultural Services Composting and Soil Blending Facility. The LEA is certified by the California Integrated Waste Management Board to enforce state laws and regulations at solid waste facilities within the County and City of Sacramento.

## **Description of project and LEA's determination**

Lopez Agricultural Services is a 160 acre site in the County of Sacramento and is owned and operated by Al Lopez. Lopez Agricultural Services is designed to assist the County of Sacramento and other jurisdictions in complying with local waste reduction and recycling goals and ordinances. Lopez Agricultural Services accepts green waste, wood waste, gypsum, and other agricultural material. This facility is located at 11499 Florin Road, Sacramento, CA, 95830.

On June 13, 2008, the LEA received from Lopez Agricultural, a Solid Waste Facility Permit/Waste Discharge Requirements (CIWMB E-177) application package to amend the RCSI requesting to revise the document to:

- Add language to the Load Checking section to change load checking requirements for wood waste and green waste loads.
- Windrow dimensions increased to provide operational flexibility.
- Update the cover page, table of contents, tables, and the footer pages to reflect the current version.

No other changes to the SWFP are under consideration at this time. The LEA finds that the proposed changes are consistent with the California Integrated Waste Management Board State Minimum Standards, and is consistent with all applicable certified and/or adopted California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) documents. The proposed changes do not conflict with the terms and conditions in the current Solid Waste Facilities Permit. The LEA approved the amendment on July 11, 2008
